

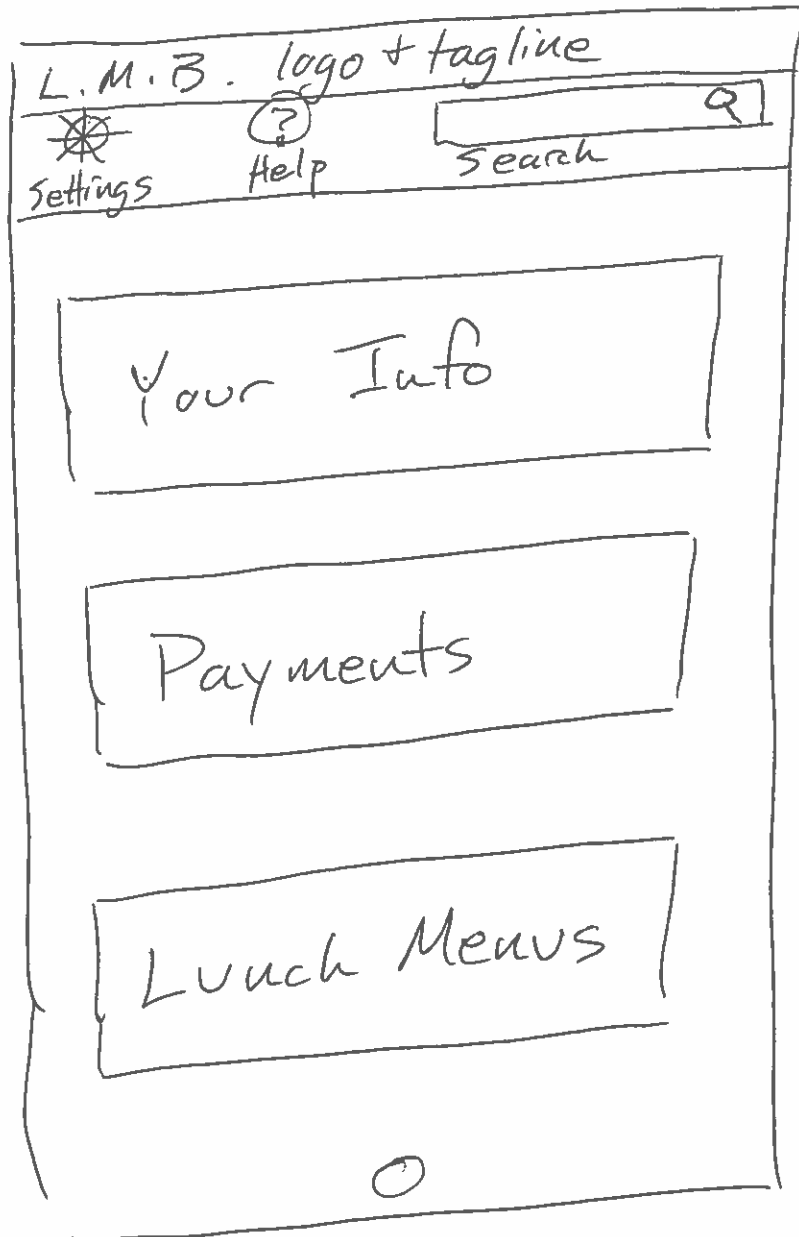

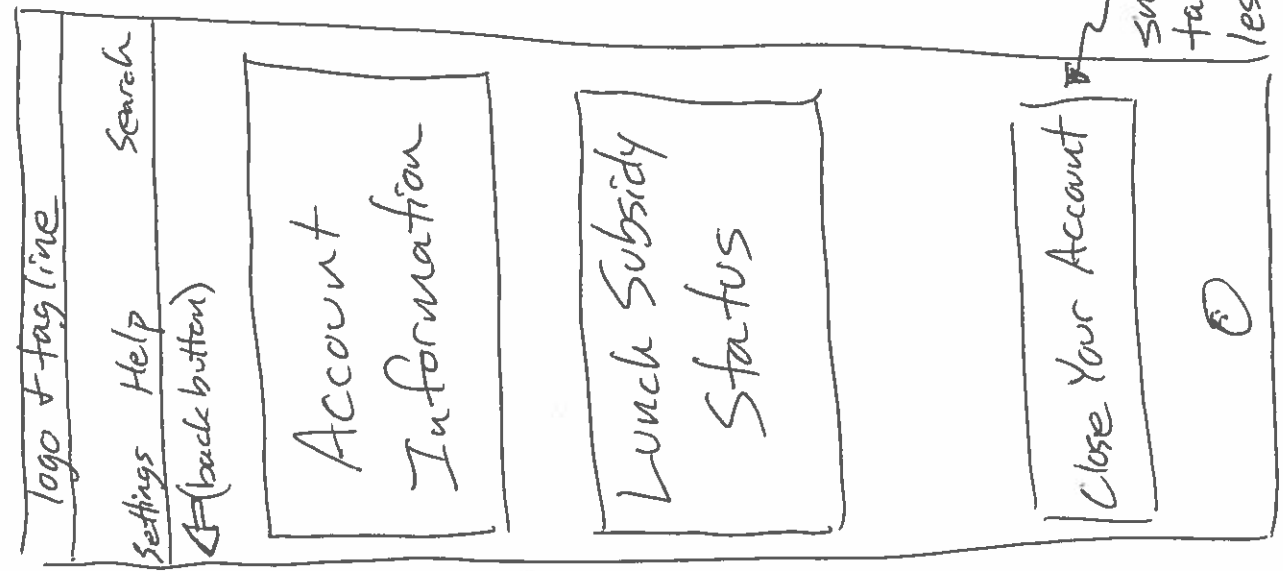


3 main groupings of functionality are large tap targets, and double as mini-dashboards

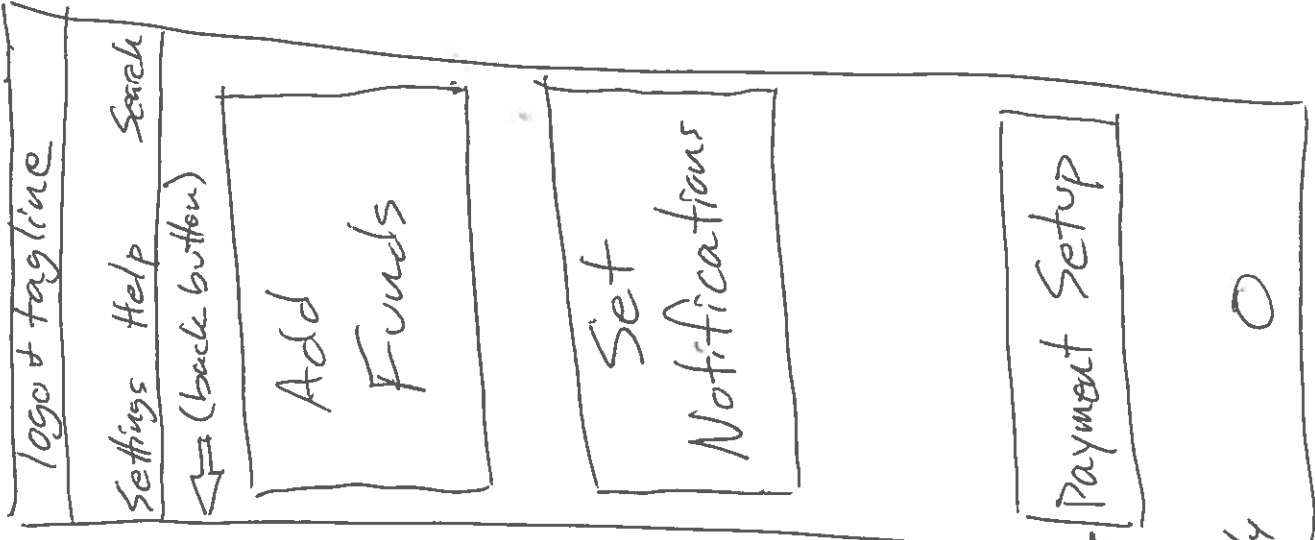

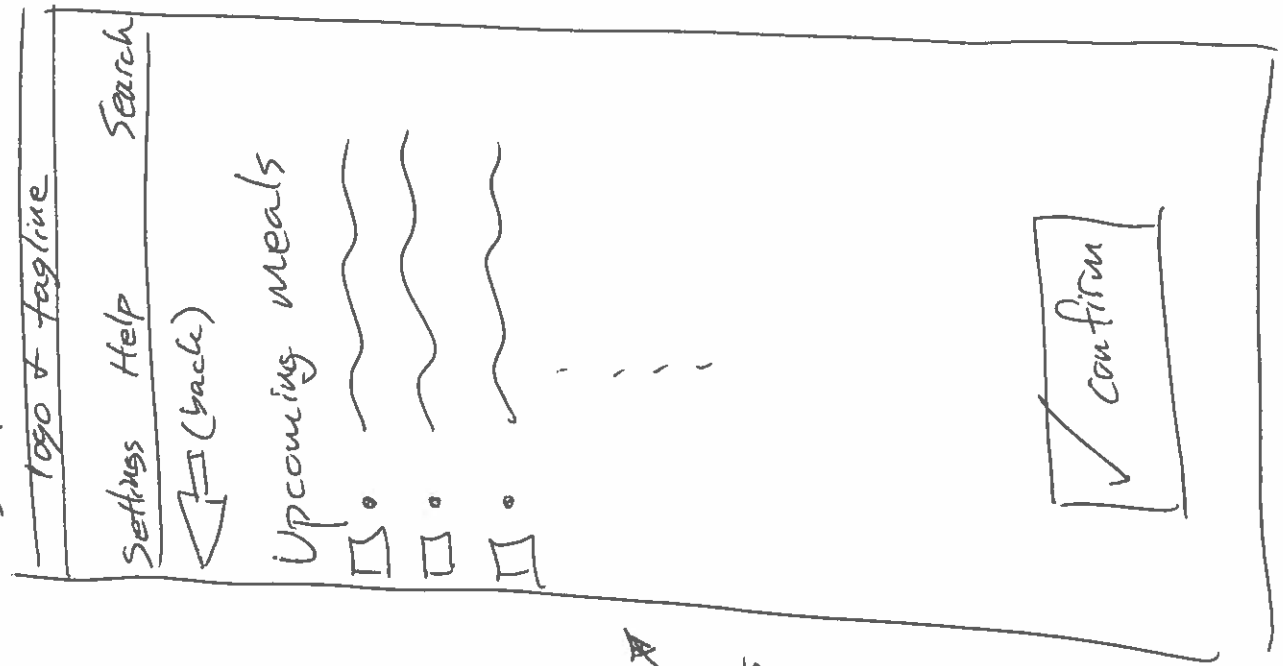

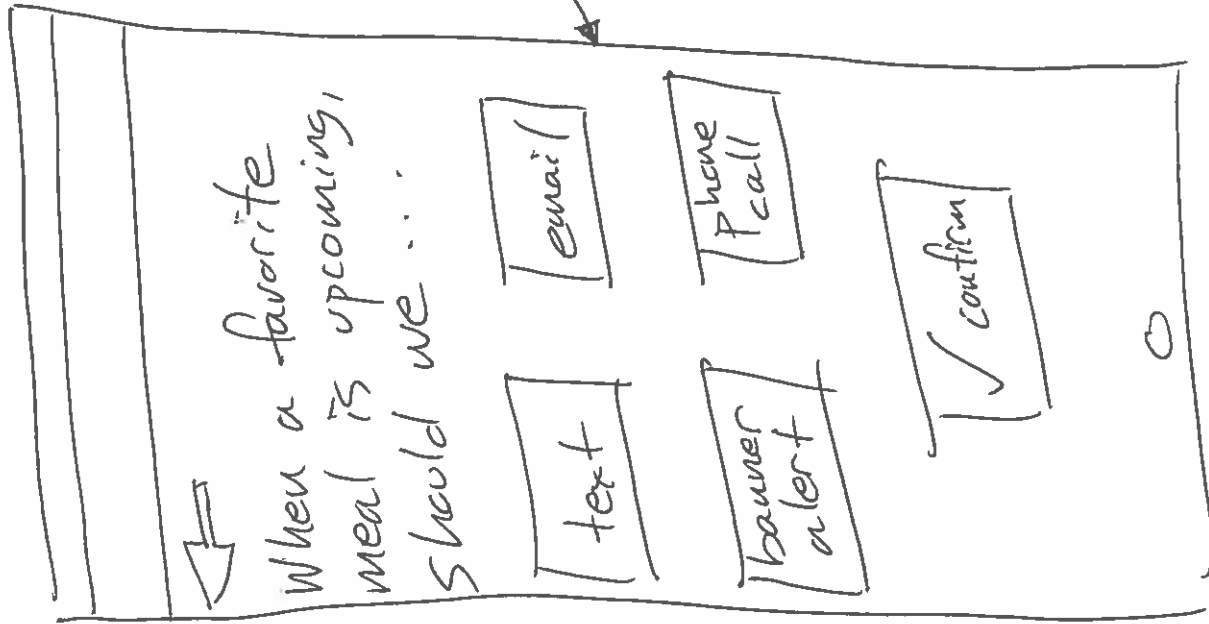

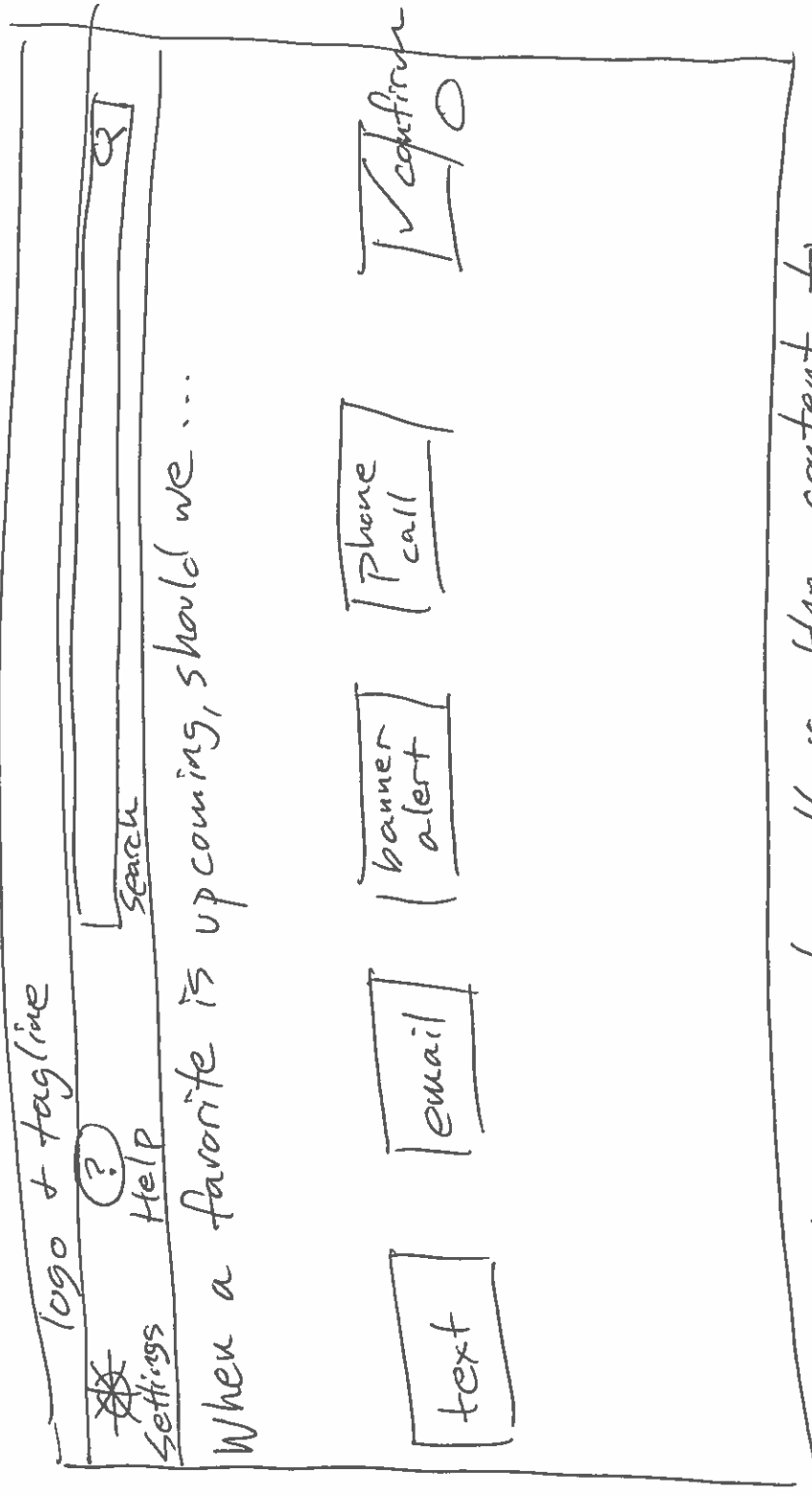
## Favorite Meal Reminders

# Landscape mode - Lunch menus



- vast majority of families with children under 18 have  $\leq 2$  children, so the landscape mode allows the menus to sit side-by-side without the need for scrolling
- can also fit a slightly wider calendar
